


ANNUAL REPORT FOR 2022

His mom came up to our booth and told us that a year or two before, Dylan was in the hospital and received a care package similar to our Smile Bags. She let me know how much it meant to him at the time, and how he still had that one stuffed animal in his room. Later that fall, I received an email from Dylan telling me he wanted to raise money for Simple Gifts Project as part of his upcoming bar mitzvah project. He was hopeful he could help other patients and make a difference in their life, and pay it all forward.

By the Spring of 2022, Dylan had raised \$1020! In April, he and his whole family came and filled 100 care bags: 25 Smile Bags, 35 parent bags and 40 teen bags. The thoughtfulness and giving spirit of a 13 year old helped put smiles on a hundred faces! Thank you to Dylan and his family for their time, their generosity, and their kindness.

PLANS FOR 2023 INCLUDE...

- Hosting even more fundraisers with schools, scout troops, and community groups throughout the year.
- Continuing to fill and donate Smile, Teen and Parent Bags to local hospitals.
- Starting a new series of fundraisers at Allora Gifts in Doylestown this Spring. We will be holding cupcake decorating classes for adults where all proceeds go directly to our SGP school initiatives.
- Working with Barclay Elementary on a pilot program to create lessons and activities that elementary teachers can use to promote kindness, compassion, and empathy in and out of the classroom.
